cacique maravilla — chile

Born in Yumbel in the Bio Bio Valley, Manuel Humberto Moraga Gutiérrez is the 7th generation (dating back to the conquistadors!) owner of Cacique Maravilla: he has a lifelong relationship with the land and the farm. With the first vines planted in 1766, today, his wines are still made naturally with a traditional, ancestral approach. Committed to showcasing the grapes' characteristics by preserving Chile's agriculture and honouring its historical winemaking traditions, the vineyards are dry-farmed for a fuller expression of the unique volcanic soils and all farm work is done organically.

sauvignon blanc central valley 2017

Apart from being of amazing value, Maravilla's Sauvignon Blanc is light, refreshing, and oh-so-easy to enjoy. The nose is ripe citrus and the palate follows through with pink grapefruit, passionfruit, and a hint of lime. Good acidity. Brilliant with chèvre, salads, and shellfish.
